EYFS Entrance will change	The swimming pool will be placed in the KS1 playground. This means ALL EYFS children will need to enter through the main EYFS entrance. When entering the playground, please keep a large distance from the pool and monitor your children closely. Be aware of cables and pipes.
After School Sessions Years 1 - 6 If your child is in year 1 or 2, please stay to help them get dried and changed. Times: 15:30 - 16:00: Swimming Lesson 16:00 - 16:30: Fun Swim Cost: £4 per body Adults may join at the same fee. If your child is entitled to 1-1 support, adult usage is free, however, you will need to book a space via Scopay which will be refunded. Booking: Please book via Scopay onto the sessions you desire.	 We will be offering after school swim sessions every day during the 3 weeks of the pool being at the school. Parents can wait in the KS1 playground area whilst your child is with our qualified lifeguards or return at pick up. If you book onto the 15:30 session, school staff will bring your child to the pool. If you book onto the 16:00 session, please ensure your child is at the pool for 15:50 to allow time to get changed and get full usage.
